

HOME / TIMELINE

The home page serves as a content aggregator, presenting a feed of constantly changing content from a users entire social network.


Content is limited to content types that are common to all users: Photos/Videos, Music, Events and Compilations.



MY PROFILE

The Personal Profile view represents the published version of the data a user manages in their PC client. This view allows the user to see and manage the content in it's published form in order to share it with their community.


In addition to published content, sharing preferences, page layout options and private content modules such as calls and modules are provided.



PUBLIC PROFILE

The Public Profile represents and users Personal Profile viewed by another person. The content and page layout are displayed as the authoring user has determined.

Private content and page layout options are not available.

Homepage

The Homepage is the default landing page for Samsung LifeDiary. Users must sign in to view content. The following items are they core UI elements found on the homepage. Additional details are available on following pages.

Page Elements

1 Navigation Bar Navigation includes LifeDiary Home (linking to timeline), My LifeDiary (personal profile), and any temporary tabs for content or user profiles recently viewed.

In addition to the primary navigation tabs described above, dropdowns for Friends, Groups, and Favorites are available at all times in the navigation bar.


2 Finder The Finder is the key navigational aid for the timeline. The Finder displays a list of content items sorted by time. Users can switch views by clicking one of the links at the bottom of the finder. In addition, there are two filter options:

Social Filters Allow the user to choose a filter based on a social group (predefined or user created).

Content Filters Allow the user to select a specific content type to view.

3 Navigation Timeline A smaller version of the main timeline that allows the user to navigate more efficiently. The user may zoom between "Zoomed In" and "Zoomed Out" views.

4 Shared Content Content is displayed on the timeline in one of three forms. These forms are described in more detail on the following pages. The summary view of a content items is displayed in this example (see "Zoom States" for more examples).

People View

The People View is one of the alternative views of the timeline. It represents the social relationships within the system. The relationships that people have to others and to their media.

View Elements

1 Social Clusters The main content is arranged into clusters of social relations. Lines are drawn to connect the users to events, compilations, music, pictures, or video that they share in common. Strong and weak ties are represented accordingly in 3D space. (ie weaker ties appear further back.)

Degree Rings Rings stemming from the user in central focus represent the relationships degree of separation from the user. Media contained in the first ring is first degree of separation from the user, while that contained in the second ring is second degree.

2 Finder The finder in this case is displayed by author. Selecting an entry in the finder jumps the user to that focus in the content window. Users can switch views by clicking one of the links at the bottom of the finder.

3 Navigation Timeline A smaller version of the main timeline that allows the user to navigate more efficiently. The user may zoom between "Zoomed In" and "Zoomed Out" views.

Location View

The Location View is another alternative view of the timeline. It represents the geo-physical relationships within the system. These places are mapped on a navigational map.

View Elements

1 Map The map contains events, compilations, music, pictures, and video plotted by location. The details are shown as the when the user clicks on a piece of media.

2 Finder The finder in this case is displayed by media object. Selecting an entry in the finder jumps the user to that focus in the content window. Users can switch views by clicking one of the links at the bottom of the finder.

3 Navigation Timeline A smaller version of the main timeline that allows the user to navigate more efficiently. The user may zoom between "Zoomed In" and "Zoomed Out" views.

4 Pan and Zoom The pan and zoom feature allows the user to zoom in or zoom out of the map views based, purely by location. Note: this contrasts the zooming in the timeline view, which allows media and aggregates to be focused on by time.

The is a default user profile showing the logged in user's personal data (both public and private).

Page Elements

1 Profile Module The profile module displays an avatar and select metadata related to the user. More detailed profile information can be linked to from the module.

2 Friends The user's friends are displayed here. Thumbnails link to each contacts public LifeDiary.

3 Calls & Messages The Calls and Messages modules are optional and private by default. A case still needs to be made for the inclusion of these elements since the user will already have access to them via the PC client.

4 Page Customization Tools A Micro Blog module displays all micro blog submissions from the community. These may be text messages sent directly to LifeDiary or guest book entries from the user's personal profile. This is TBD.



1 Compilation Listing Item

The item includes:

- compilation entry title: links to entry detail
- entry text: may be the full text of the entry or the first 500 words
- date and time posted
- location from which it was posted
- privacy setting (if private)
- owner name (if shared)
- number of comments: links to entry detail
- tags associated with entry: links to list of all entries matching that tag
- links to add comment, share with others or add to favorites.

Note: entries may include media (photos, video or audio)

2 Tags

A list of all the tags associated with entries.

Includes:

- tag name (keyword): links to list of all entries matching that tag
- number of entries with that tag

Note: tags may be shown in the form of a "tag cloud" rather than a list.

3 Archive

Lists the number of entries by month. Includes:

- month/year: linked to a list of all entries posted during that time
- number of entries posted during that month/year

1 Introductory Copy
The copy should convey what the Samsung Life Diary product is, how the user can join and participate in the community, and provide the user with a sense of what the product is like through screenshots or a demo.

Optional copy: specify what Samsung handsets are compatible with the mobile client of Life Diary, and which carriers carry those handsets.

2 Screenshots/Demo
Screenshots of the Samsung Life Diary product are displayed within the page, providing the user with the ability to click through and view each in turn

3 Sign In/Registration Widget
Allows registered users to sign into the Life Diary site. Suggested authentication based on email address and user-defined password (TBD). If user has forgotten their password they may request the site to email or reset their password (TBD). The user may also choose to always be signed in. Completing the input fields and selecting "Sign In" takes the user through the Login Flow.

If the user is not a registered user, they may initiate registration by selecting "Register for Life Diary" link. This takes them through the Registration flow.

4 Download Callout
Signed out users have the option of downloading the Life Diary PC client from this page. The callout copy should convey the benefits of the PC client, as well its hardware/software compatibility requirements.

Selecting the "Download" button takes the user through the Download flow.



3.1 Navigation Bar


The Nav Bar is present on every page within LifeDiary and provides persistent access to primary areas such as Home and My LifeDiary. The Home and My LifeDiary tabs are permanent and cannot be removed. **1**

The Nav Bar also includes three dropdown menus **2**

Friends. Friends menu has list of friends and link to manage friends list. Selecting a friend will load their profile page and add a tab to the Nav Bar for that profile.


Groups. Groups menu has list of groups the member has joined.

Favorites. Favorites is a list of bookmarked content and links directly to detail views of content.



Removeable Tabs



Personal profile and content detail screens are represented with removeable tabs. Ideally these tabs would be saved between sessions.




The finder is a navigational aid that provides the user the ability to filter timeline content by social filter, content type, and to quickly navigate to new content.

Note: In the timeline view the title of the media being posted is highlighted. In the people view, the queue highlights the name of the author.

Today Button
The today button repositions the timeline to center on the current day. This works in both day and week views.

Views Navigation
Clicking on these links navigates users between timeline, people, and map views.

Timeline Scale Options
There are two time scale options for the timeline: day view and week view.

Content filters allow the user to quickly focus on a specific type of content. Choosing a filter will adjust the timeline and finder to display only the selected type of content. Filters include:







Filters are used to bring certain content types to the foreground of the user's attention. When a content type filter is selected, the other content types are visually pushed to the background, but are still actionable.

- 1 Filter: View All**
This filter is selected by default. All content types are shown with equal priority treatment.
- 2 Filter: Content Type**
When a content type filter is selected, all units of that content type are scaled to be the same size, regardless of whether they are connected to events.


Social Filter

The social filter dropdown includes a list of pre-determined filters such as "My Friends" and "Just Me". These provide useful access to unique views of the data. In addition to pre-determined filters, user-created filters may be generated. These would allow the user to create a custom filter based on groups or individuals.

Selecting "Manage Filters" from the social filter dropdown displays the Filters screen.



1 The Filters screen displays a list of filters.

1A - The "Just Me" filter cannot be edited or removed.

1B - New filters can be created with the "New Filter" option.

1C - Edit and Remove options are available for custom filters.


2 The Edit Filter screen displays a list of "All My Friends" and a list of friends that are associated with the selected filter. Users may select any number of friends in the friends list to add to the filter.

2A - The all friends list contains a complete list of all friends associated with the user's lifediary.

2B - Friends can be added or removed to the filter using the add and remove buttons. If one or more friend in the all friends list is selected, the remove option is not available and should be grayed out. If one or more friends in the filter are selected, the add option is not available and should be grayed out.

2C - The name of the selected filter is displayed here.

2D - Pressing "Save Changes" saves the current filter and returns to the filter screen.



Timeline Navigation

This section describes the two primary ways of navigating the timeline: by clicking and dragging to explore the timeline, and by scaling the timeline to navigate between Zoomed-In (day view) and Zoomed-Out (week or month view).



Exploring the Timeline

The timeline is divided into two parts: the "main timeline" and the "navigation timeline". The main timeline takes up the majority of the screen and can be interacted with by grabbing with the cursor and dragging in one direction (1). The navigation timeline represents a scaled version of the main timeline and is used to quickly navigate (2). Any movement in either timeline is reflected in the other.

Timeline Scale Options

There are two time scale options for the timeline: day view and week view.




Media Types:

Throughout manipulation of the timeline two distinct media types are used. Below we define the following types of media and their home-state appearance. We outline the change in their home states in the rest of this section.

1 Single Media Icon
Media types throughout this section refer to photos/videos and music. A thumbnail icon or dot will represent each piece of media.

2 Aggregate Media Icon
A compilation or event represent an aggregate of media icons. Each contains a title and content. The content of an aggregate is media (photos or music). An aggregate is represented as a cluster of single media icons.






3 Aggregate roll-over
 When an *event region* is approached rolled over with the mouse, the small icons associated with that event turn into thumbnails which can be individually selected. When the user leaves the *event region*, the event region minimizes to its original minimized state.

4 Aggregate select
 When a single item in an *event region* is selected, it displays the content highlights. The content highlights include media posted to that event title, along with other related compilations and tags. *Songs and photos* are those pieces of media that have been added to the event title. *Related compilations and tags* share or contain the event title string.

Clicking the event title brings the viewer to an event summary view. Clicking a thumbnail brings the viewer to the media detail page.





When one of the three product types is selected, this template treatment is shown on mouse-click. Highlights about the single item are shown with an opportunity to select "Show more info", which takes the user to a detail of the item.



- 1 All the friends that a user has added are displayed on the screen. The page should scroll accordingly. Friends are displayed with their user icon or avatar, and group (shared with user) and status information is included as well.
 - 2 Drop down provides filter functionality. Filters include:
 - 1. All Friends
 - 2. Groups (any groups the user has joined)
 - 3 Users may add a friend to their Friends list. "Add a Friend" button links to find a friend page.
- Note: Add Friend feature is not available to visitors of a public profile.
- 4 There is a "Remove Friend" function associated with each friend. Initiating remove friend will result in a "Are you sure?" confirmation before removing the friend permanently from the list.




This flow demonstrates the different paths a user can take to navigate between the timeline and content detail pages. In this way, the timeline plays two key roles: providing access to user profiles which aggregate user generated content into a customizable templates, and providing access to content detail pages.

- 1 User navigates to content item of interest by selecting it in the finder.**
When an item is selected in the timeline finder, the timeline repositions to focus on the summary view of that item.
- 2 User navigates to content detail.**
From the summary view of the content item, the user selects the "View Details" link. This link takes the user directly to the content detail page for that item.



- 3 User navigates to user profile.**
From the summary view of the content item, the user selects the name of the user who shared the content. This link takes them to the user profile for that person.
- 4 User navigates to content detail from the user profile.**
From the user profile, selecting any content item displays the content detail for that item.

Content Detail



Users may customize their personal profile page via the customize feature.

- 1 Customization options are available only for the profile owner and are accessed in the upper right area of the page via the "Customize" link.
- 2 The ability to drag and drop modules directly on their profile screen, allows users to build their own pages.
- 3 Users may also choose from several pre-defined layout templates to help quickly guide layout.
- 4 Multiple "theme" options that affect color palette, graphical treatment, and fonts are available.
- 5 Having selected a combination of layout and theme, the user may either preview (displays profile content full-screen with new look & feel) or save changes and return to the profile page.


Users can add content modules to their profile page with the "Add Content" feature.

- 1 The 'Add Content' link is only available to profile owners and is not displayed in the public view of a profile.




